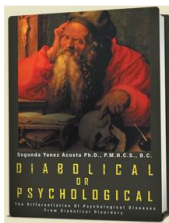


Holy Trinity Jubilee Park

We are seeking dynamic, proactive, devout Catholics to help in our work of evangelization and to assist in our projects at Holy Trinity Jubilee Park.

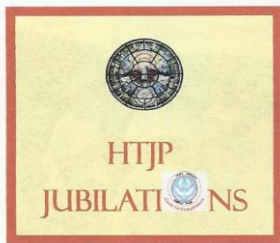
